




Symptom	What to do
No or low sound from speakers	<ul> <li>Make sure: <ul> <li>Speakers are on.</li> <li>All cables are fully inserted and power cord is connected.</li> <li>Computer and other sources are not muted.</li> <li>Volume of computer and other sources are set to 75 percent of maximum volume.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Adjust volume on speaker, computer, keyboard, media player and music application.</li> </ul>
Sound is distorted or you hear static	<ul><li>Decrease volume of source.</li><li>Increase volume of speakers.</li></ul>
Background noise when audio is not playing	<ul><li>Decrease volume of speakers.</li><li>Increase volume of other sources.</li></ul>
Power light is dim (power save mode = 30 minutes inactivity)	Play audio.
Speakers are dirty	<ul> <li>Clean with a soft, dry cloth.</li> <li>Note: Do not spray liquid on the speakers.</li> <li>Lightly vacuum grills.</li> </ul>
Control pod does not adhere to tabletop	Clean bottom surface with lint-free, slightly damp cloth.
