外接音源的蓝牙对接步骤







①打开蓝牙开关,搜索蓝牙名称: "CSJ-05A" ②点击"CSJ-05A",进行配对 ③指示灯显示蓝色,提示音响起配对成功 ④打开设备播放音乐

通过连接另售的CSJ-05可实现立体声播放功能。



在CSJ-05A与CSJ-05配对连接状态下,可实现 CSJ-05A之间的扩展连接。



同时使用两台CSJ-05A可实现蓝牙无线立体声播放功能。



两只CSJ-05A之间的TWS对接步骤 ①长按蓝牙开关直至绿灯亮起,此时TWS功能打开 ②将另一台CSJ-05A以同样方式打开,此时自动连接 ③第一台打开的CSJ-05A默认为左通道,连接手机等蓝牙终端 ④后打开的CSJ-05A会自动连接到第一台,为右通道

Safe Use Of Device



Meanings of graphic symbols



A lightning-shaped arrow in a triangle figure indicates that there is uninsulated dangerous voltage in the device enough to make people get an electric shock.



An exclamation mark in a triangle figure indicates that there are important operation and maintenance instructions (services) on the prints attached to the device.

Do not place in an unstable position

Make sure that the device is always placed horizontally and remains stable. Do not place it on a bracket or inclined plane that is easy to shake.

Do not bend the power cord or place heavy objects on it

Do not excessively wind or bend the power cord, and do not place heavy objects on it. It may damage the power cord, causing the power cord to break and short circuit. Power cord damage may cause fire and electric shock!

Avoid extended connection at high volume

Sound levels produced by this device when used with speakers may cause permanent hearing loss. Do not operate the device at very high (or uncomfortable) volumes for long periods of time. If you experience hearing loss or tinnitus, stop using the device immediately and seek medical advice promptly.

A Warning

Turn off the device in case of abnormality or failure

When the following situations occur, turn off the device immediately, unplug the power cord from the socket, and request maintenance service from your dealer.

- · Power cord or plug is damaged;
- · Smoke or abnormal smell appears:
- · Objects fall into the device or liquid is spilled on the device;
- The device gets wet by rain (or damp for other reasons):
- The device seems to operate abnormally or change significantly during use.

Adults must supervise where children are present

When using the device where children are present. pay attention to avoid incorrect operation. Adults should always be there to supervise and guide.

Do not drop or suffer strong collision

Protect device from strong collision. (Do not drop!)

Do not share a socket with too many other devices

Do not forcibly share the power cord of this device with too many other devices. When using the extension cord, please be extra careful: the total power of all devices connected to the extension cord socket must not exceed the rated power (watt/amp) of the extension cord. Excessive load may cause the insulation layer on the power cord to heat up or even melt.

- Check the voltage value of local AC power supply
- Do not connect the power cord to a DC power supply.

The device must be connected to the arid power socket with grounding protection.

When connecting speaker terminals, it is required that trained personnel perform the connection or use ready-made flexible cord or wire.

The device and AC adapter should be placed in a well-ventilated location.

Manage cable safety

Do your best to avoid intertwining the power cord and cable. In addition, all power cords and cables should be placed out of the reach of children.

Avoid stepping on the top of the device or placing heavy objects on it

Do not step on the top of the device or put heavy objects on it.

Do not connect or disconnect the power cord with wet hands

When plugging the power cord into the socket or remove it from the socket, do not touch the power cord or its plug with wet hands.

Keep small objects out of the reach of children

When the device is not used for a long time

When you want to leave home for a long time. please cut OFF the power supply and remove the power cord from the AC power socket. It can prevent accidents or fires.

The device should avoid water drops or water splashes, and containers containing liquid like vases should not be placed on the device.

Power cord and plug

For the sake of safety, do not twist the power cord or step on it, especially the plug. The polarized plug has two contact pins, one wide and one narrow, while a grounding plug has two contact pins and a grounding pin. Please do not damage the grounding pin or the wide contact pin provided for safety purposes.

Power supply

Only connect this device to the power source with the specification the same as that indicated in the manual and on the rear panel. Any improper operation may cause damage to the device and personal safety. When the device is idle for a long time or during thunderstorms, please disconnect it from the power source.

Fuses

In order to prevent fire or any damage to your device, please only use the fuse of the specification and model specified in the manual. Before changing the fuse, please turn off and disconnect the power supply of the device.

Cleaning

Do not use organic agents such as benzene or alcohol to clean the device. Dry cloth can be used.

Service

Contact professional service personnel to repair the device only.

Only use the accessories or parts recommended by the manufacturer.

Bluetooth connection steps for external sound source







- ① Turn on the Bluetooth switch and search the Bluetooth name "CSJ-05A"
- 2 Click "CSJ-05A" for pairing
- ③ When the indicator lights turns blue and a warning tone sounds, the pairing succeeds
- ④ Turn on this device to play music

Achieve stereo play by connecting to CSJ-05 which is sold separately.



The extended connection between CSJ-05A can be achieved when CSJ-05A and CSJ-05 are paired and connected.



Using two sets of CSJ-05A at the same time can achieve Bluetooth wireless stereo play.



Steps of connecting TWS between two sets of CSJ-05A

- ① Hold the Bluetooth switch until the green light is on, then the TWS function is enabled
- (2) Turn on the other CSJ-05A in the same way for automatic connection
- ③ The first CSJ-05A turned on is the left channel by default, connected to the Bluetooth terminals such as mobile phone
- ④ The CSJ-05A turned on later will automatically connect to the first one as the right channel

Note:

- The Bluetooth will automatically connect to the Bluetooth device that was connected. Disconnect the connected device before re-searching and connecting to a new one.
- 2. The slave set with TWS function will resume TWS connection with the host even after the Bluetooth is restarted by short press. If you need to reset the host or use it alone, turn off the Bluetooth function of both CSJ-05A in TWS mode at the same time, and then turn on the CSJ-05A to be set as the host to reset the Bluetooth.
